Section 3. Composition and Information on Ingredients

Chemical Name: Ocotea quixos leaf oil

Trade Name: Ishpink Essential Oil

Chemical Characterization: Essential oil.

Concentration: 100 %

Declared Allergenic Constituents: cinnamal, linalool, benzyl benzoate.

Section 4. First Aid Measures

General Information: Liquid may be irritating to skin and eyes.

Inhalation: Move person to a ventilated area and follow normal first aid procedures.

Skin Contact: Wash with water and soap and rinse thoroughly.

Eye Contact: Rinse the open eye for several minutes under running water. If symptoms persist, consult a doctor.

Personal Precautions: Wear protective equipment.

Containment and Cleaning Up: Small spills: wipe up with paper rags and place contaminated items in a closed metal waste container. Large spills: use non-flammable absorbent. Note the high danger of slipping due to spilled product.

Waste Disposal: Follow local, state, provincial and federal laws.

Section 7. Handling and Storage

Handling: Ensure good ventilation at the workplace. Keep ignition sources away. Do not smoke.

Storage: Ensure good ventilation and protect from direct light exposure. Storage in one common storage facility is not required. Keep container tightly sealed.

General Protective and Hygienic Measures: Keep away from foodstuffs, beverages and feed. Remove all soiled and contaminated clothing. Wash hands before breaks and at the end of work. Avoid contact with the eyes and skin.

Respiratory Protection: As with all materials, avoid casual breathing of vapors. Local exhaust is recommended.

Hand Protection: Wear gloves to avoid skin contact.

Eye Protection: Tightly sealed goggles.
